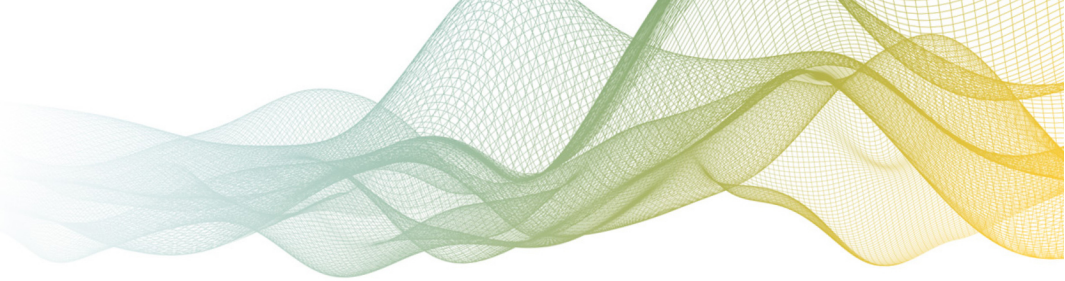

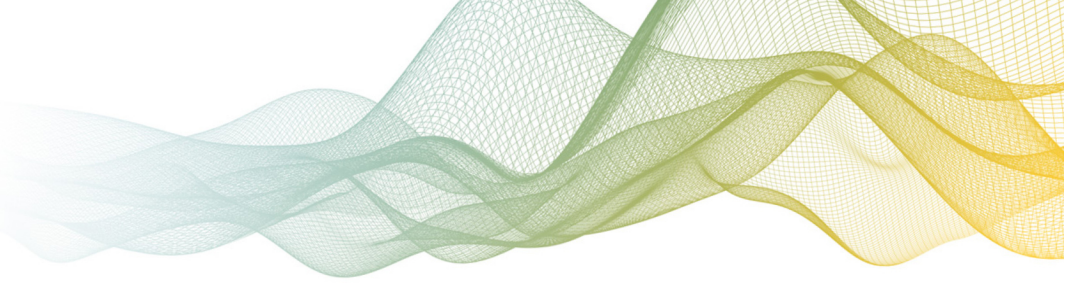

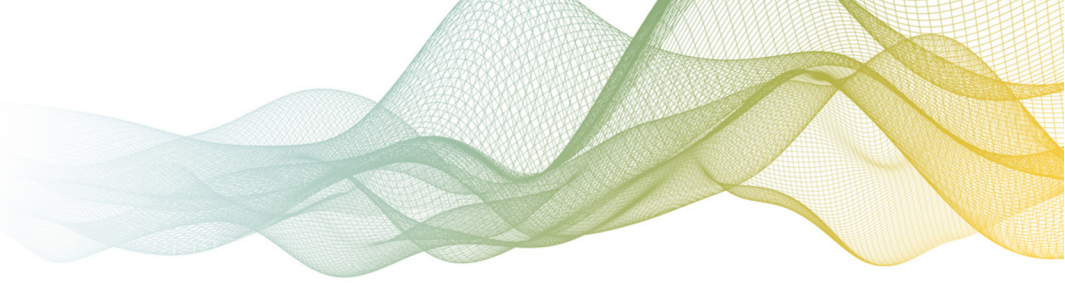

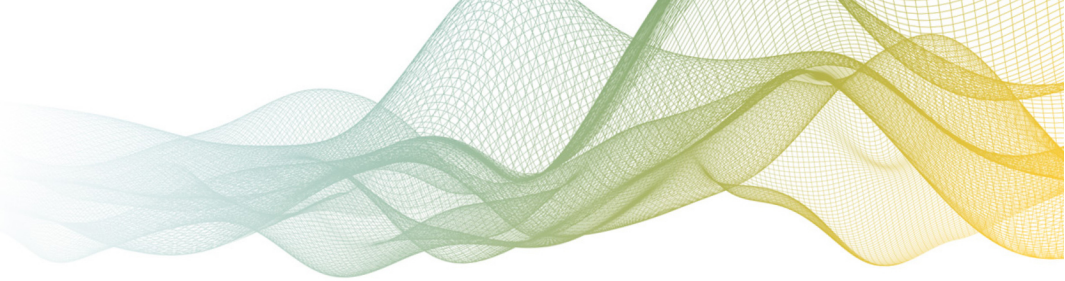

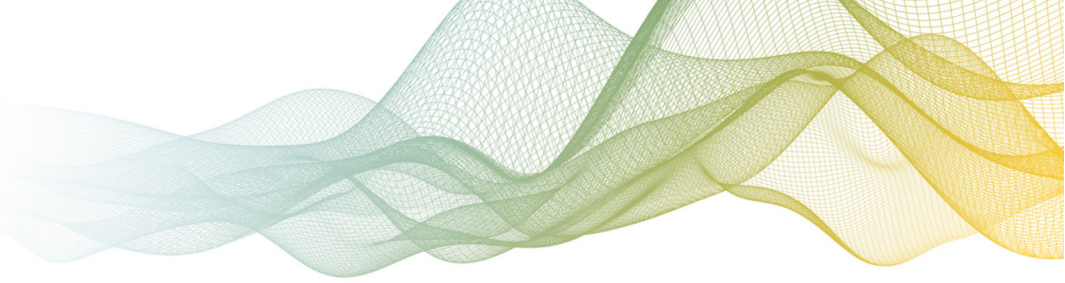

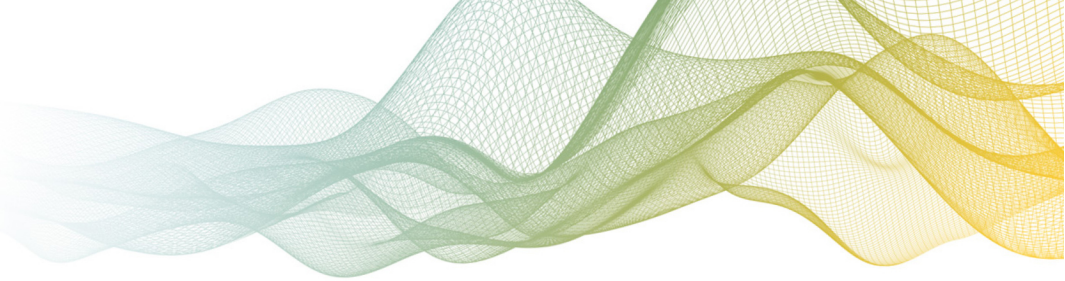

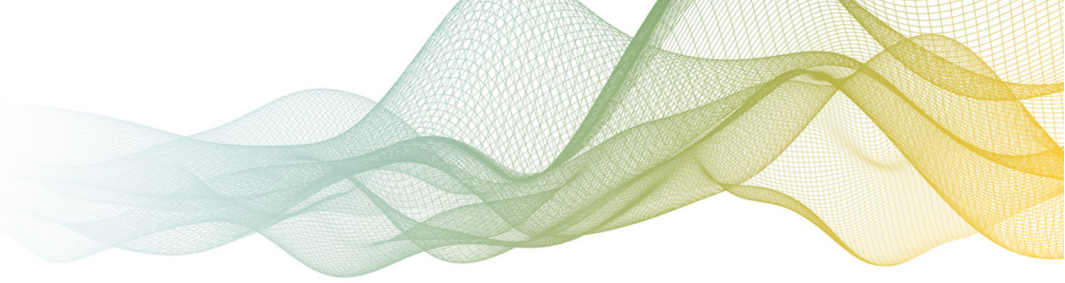

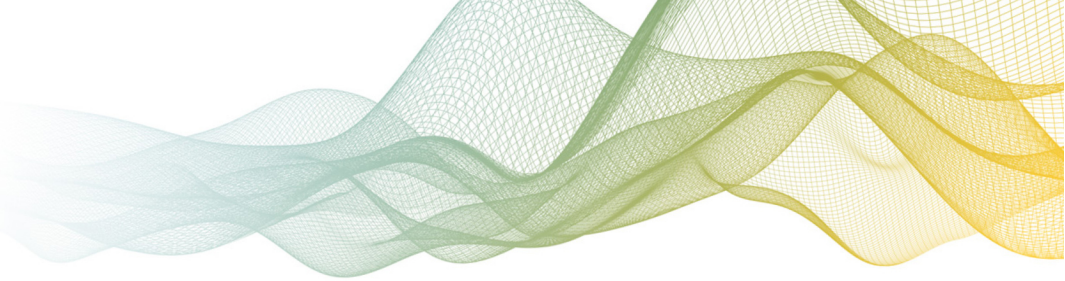

Major legal trials are decided based on weaker testimony than was provided in the May 9, 2001 National Press Club briefing on UFOs



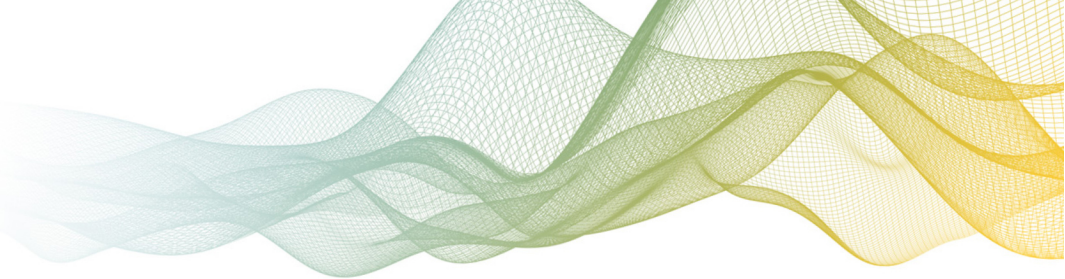
